

RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR USE OF THE POOL

1. The following rules will be strictly enforced and are in part requirements of the Northampton Board of Health. Any infraction of the pool rules may result in loss of pool privileges and Owners may be subject to fines.
2. The swimming pool and surrounding area are for the express use of residents and their guests.
3. A pool key card **is required** to gain access to the pool area. A pool key may be obtained from the management company. There is a \$10 charge for new or lost key cards. Each Unit is entitled to two guest passes. Each guest must carry a guest pass and must be accompanied by a River Run Occupant with a key card.
4. Anyone less than 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian 18 years of age or older.
5. There will be no climbing on or over the pool fence at any time.
6. Use of the pool facility is "***Strictly at Your Own Risk.***" ***THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.***
7. Pool Hours are published annually and strictly enforced. Swimming after hours will result in loss of pool privileges and Owners are subject to fines.
8. Swimsuits are required at all times. No cut-off shorts or torn tee shirts are allowed as strings will clog the pool filters.
9. All persons must shower before entering the pool.
10. Persons suffering from any type of infectious disease are prohibited from entering the pool. No person wearing a bandage or medical covering of any kind or having evidence of skin disease or sores shall be allowed to use the pool. No person shall blow their nose or spit or in any other way contaminate the pool or its walkways or bathrooms. Any person who is incontinent, including infants and toddlers in diapers is not allowed in the pool. "Little Swimmers" or other similar products designed for pool use are acceptable.
11. No running, jumping, horseplay, large floating devices, yelling, obscene language or unsafe diving or jumping is allowed in the pool area. Throwing rocks or any other such objects into the pool will result in immediate loss of pool privileges and Owners are subject to fines.
12. No alcoholic beverages, food or glass containers are allowed in the pool area. Any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted in the pool

area. Smoking is allowed if cigarette butts are disposed of in appropriate containers supplied by the individual.

13. Trash is to be disposed of in the proper container before you leave the pool area so that everyone will be able to enjoy a pleasant atmosphere.
14. Radios must be used with earphones.
15. Wet bathing suits are not allowed in the community room of the clubhouse.
16. Only service animals will be allowed in the pool area.
17. No storage of personal items such as lawn chairs, towels, shoes, clothing, toys etc. is allowed in the pool area, clubhouse or rest rooms.
18. Management, staff, and Trustees reserve the right to deny the use of the pool to anyone not adhering to the above rules, for other rule infractions on the property, or for other reasons that might jeopardize anyone's safety.
